The museum takes a special interest in area students, and offers group and student tours at a discount. Students can tour the different galleries and learn the achievements of Black politicians, scientists, educators, sports figures, women, and military heroes (Lt. Henry O. Flipper and Buffalo Soldiers). Exhibits range from the earliest African American through the turbulent struggle for racial equality and the triumph of our First African American president.
